How to Make Anti-microbial, Mosquito-repelling Soap

Ingredients

- ½ kilograms peanut/ordinary soap
- 1.25 liters of water
- 1 teaspoon of salt
- 2 kilograms of neem leaves
- 2-4 plastic containers such as water bottles or other plastic containers

Directions

1. Cut all the soap into small pieces
2. Boil 1 liter of water
3. Add the neem leaves to the water and boil for 10 minutes
4. Remove and discard the leaves
5. Add the ½ kilo of small soap pieces slowly and continue to stir
6. When all soap pieces are dissolved, add the salt and mix well.
7. Pour the liquid into plastic containers.
8. Allow the plastic containers to cool and then remove the soap from the containers for sale or use. The soap will easily fall out of wide-brimmed containers, but plastic water bottles must be cut away.

How to Make Anti-microbial, Mosquito-repelling Lotion

Ingredients - Makes 2 liters of lotion

- 1 bar of soap (Persavon)
- 1.25 liters of water
- 1 liter oil
- 1 teaspoon of perfume
- 2 kilograms of neem leaves

Directions

1. Cut all the soap into small pieces
2. Boil 2 liters of water
3. Add the neem leaves to the water and boil for 10 minutes
4. Remove and discard the leaves
5. Add the ½ kilo of small soap pieces slowly and continue to stir
6. When all soap pieces are dissolved, add the perfume.
7. Slowly add the oil and mix until desired consistency.
8. Divide the lotion into plastic bags or bottles for sale or distribution.
